REGULATION 14 PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The next public consultation step is a statutory one, known as [Regulation 14 Consultation](#). This started on 13 April 2021 with the publication of a Public Notice in the *Tiverton Gazette* and runs to 17:00 on 11 June 2021.

The Neighbourhood Plan management team presented to the Town Council at its meeting on 22 March 2021. The Council endorsed the Regulation 14 version of The Plan, effectively taking ownership of it.

In his foreword to The Plan the Mayor, Cllr Colin Slade said, "I congratulate Ian Johnson and Richard Ives for taking up the challenge, setting the structure for consultation and producing the first plan for the parish. I thank all those who have contributed and look forward to seeing the TIVVY standard applied to all future planning".

In addressing the Council, the Chairman of the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group, The Rev Ian Johnson, said, "Taking account of the 2014 attempt around 70 people have been involved in developing The Plan. I thank particularly the small band of dedicated volunteers who have worked on this Plan. We are also immensely grateful for the vast knowledge and experience that our Consultant, Alison Eardley, has contributed - we would not have been able to cope without this support".

A summary of The Plan is being distributed to all addresses in the Parish. Unfortunately, a Royal Mail system failure means that the leaflet is being distributed a bit late, but it can be downloaded from the **Documents** section stated above. Note that this is for A5 printing, but of course will print on A4.
